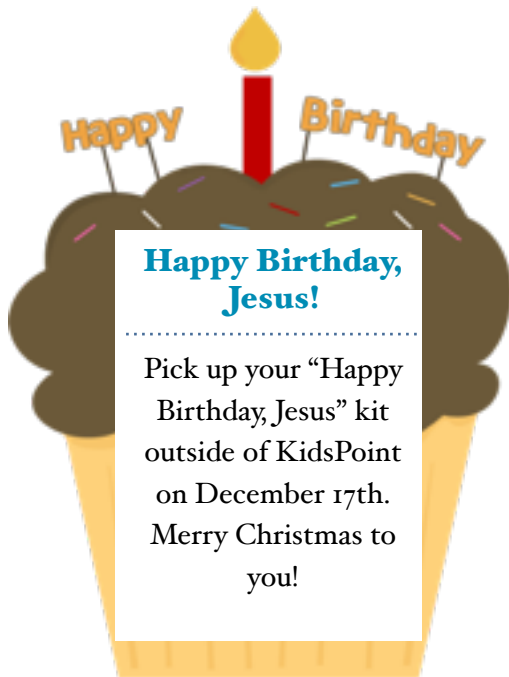


Celebrating Christ's Birth
